## First flight after annual ends in crash

FEBRUARY 10, 2016 BY GENERAL AVIATION NEWS STAFF

Maintenance gurus and NTSB reports note that incident and accident frequency increases shortly after annual inspections or maintenance! Be involved with your mechanic, help disassemble and reassemble the plane. Organize the parts.

Below is only a few items people have found after an annual:

- Throttle body pushes into instrument panel inflight (me)
- Inspection ports missing screws bend in flight (me)
- Fuel selector off
- Tools left in belly
- Missing cotter pins
- Missing safety wire
- Oil leak or no oil
- Loose plug

I'm sure most of you have a few good examples, as well!


