New Business:

1. Jim Goodspeed was nominated and unanimously elected to fill the director spot that was left by the passing of Steve Barber. Thank you, Jim for volunteering.

2. A nominating committee to select the officer slate for the upcoming two years was formed. The members of this committee are Mark Banus, Rick Jaworski, and Mateo Colmenero. Thank you gentlemen in advance for your time and efforts in this matter. 3. Portable Kitchen-The portable kitchen is in need of repair. If you call AND email it will have more impact than just an email. It is not necessary to speak to the representative directly. Calling the representative's office staff and telling them you oppose H.R. 2997's ATC privatization will be sufficient.
