"What is included in the program? There are actually two components, a logbook and access to an on line pilot training course. Sporty's is providing a special "Young Eagles" logbook that pilots can present to their passengers following the Young Eagles flight. The logbook's first entry is designed to record the details of the flight. It also provides an opportunity for the pilot to show the Young Eagle how pilots record their flight time. In addition, the pilot should encourage their Young Eagle to record other aviation experiences in the logbook, such as attending an air show or a Chapter event. It does not need to only record flight time, although the logbook is designed to meet FARs. Along with the logbook is a unique access code a child can use to access Sporty's Complete Pilot Training Course on line. Instructions for registering for the class are also included."
