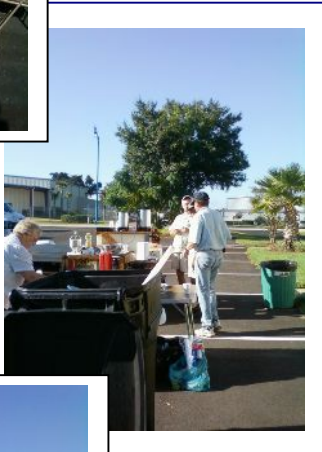




Executive Committee
