'Flying the airplane is more important than radioing your plight to a person on the ground who is incapable of understanding or doing anything about it.'

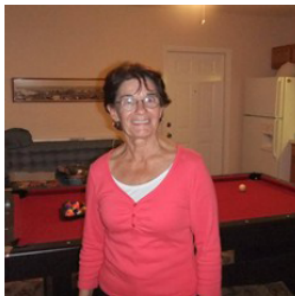

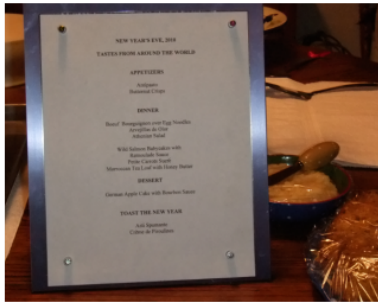
